WHERE: Carowinds Music Festival, Charlotte, NC

WHEN: Saturday, June 3rd, 2023

Itinerary

Arrive with instrument/music and concert attire: 7:00am

Depart RMS: 7:15am

Arrive Carowinds: 10:30am

Band warm-up: 11am

Band performs: 11:30am

Students Dismissed to Park: 12noon

***Band students have free time in the park with chaperone supervision at all times during our stay at Carowinds. NO student will leave the park, and all students will stay with chaperone groups.

Awards Ceremony at Carowinds Amphitheater: 5pm

Students meet at buses for departure: 8:45pm

Depart Carowinds: 9pm

Arrive Rolesville Middle School: 12midnight

COST: \$100 per student

\$60 per chaperone (this is to help us cover tickets and bus cost)

Cost includes: admission to park, coach bus transportation, music festival participation fees

Please pay by CHECK written to RMS ARTS BOOSTERS and place it in the drop box along with permission forms in envelope (please read **DUE DATE** below)

OTHER INFORMATION:

- You will need money for lunch and dinner in the park (I would recommend bringing a lunch that you can eat at the bus between our performance and entering the park)
- Attire for the day will be band tshirts and khaki shorts or pants. If you need a band tshirt, they are available for \$15 each.
- We need at least 1 chaperone per 10 children, should be 5 or 6. You **MUST** be enrolled in the volunteer registry with Wake County Schools. This is **NOT** a short process and needs to be done **VERY** soon if not already done.
- Chaperones **MUST** fill out chaperone information sheet by the time money is due. Students may request chaperone information sheets from Mr. Kohring.
- Band Chaperones must accompany us on the trip and stay with students from at least: Arrive Carowinds@10:30am to Depart Carowinds@9:00pm

DUE DATE: Check, permission forms, and health form and Chaperone requests must be completed and put in an envelope with student's name and "Carowinds" on the front. Envelopes should be in the drop box by **Friday, May 5** at the latest! Students and Chaperones will **NOT** be accepted after this date!!! (not because we don't want more, but we have to get everything ordered and paid for)

Chaperone Duties

1. Must be approved through WCPSS Volunteer System.
2. Take attendance of your group of students before loading and after exiting the bus.
3. Monitor your group of students:
 - a. Group must stay together at all times – no students should leave the group.
 - b. Students should follow park rules at all times.
 - c. Students should observe Rolesville Middle School behavior expectations at all times.
 - d. Encourage students to stay hydrated with WATER.
 - e. Students may NOT enter the water park.
4. Make sure students follow the schedule:
 - a. Students must return to the buses after our performance to put up instruments.
 - b. Students must return to the buses BEFORE 9pm
5. If you are driving yourself, chaperones must be present between arriving at the park at 10:30am through departing at 9pm.
6. Chaperones must have Mr. Kohring's cell phone number and check in with a text or phone call. Chaperones must contact Mr. Kohring if there are any medical concerns, missing student, or behavior issues.
